RESPECT THE BAGGER, THE BAG AND THE BOARD. ENJOY!



Here are some guidelines to maintaining your California Sandbag Board & Bags.

- Keep Board & Bags away from water and excessive moisture.
- Store Board in dry area.
- The board will get dusty from the Bags, we recommend a damp cloth to wipe down the surface to remove dust. This will keep the grip for when the bags hit the Board.
- If using the board on a hard surface (eg. Concrete) we recommend a 1.5m x 1m sheet of synthetic turf to place your Board on. This reduces wear on the Board and Bags.
- To clean board apply some spray & wipe and wipe off with a cloth. Danish oil can be used to recondition the Board surface.
- To avoid Bag damage do not kick the Bags or throw them further than the recommended game distance.
- We recommend using a Lob Tray while playing, this keeps the Bags off the ground and a place for your beverage.

Position Board on flat, level ground with Upright firmly seated in slot at top of board (tighten adjusting screw if Upright fit is too loose). Board should not rock or move with light hand pressure applied to the corners of the Board.

DISTANCE

Mark a throw line about 24 feet (7.3m) from Board hole centre. A player 5'10" tall will be standing 24 feet (7.3m) from Board hole centre when hole in Upright is visually centred in Board hole. Adjust distance as best suits players and conditions.

FULL COMPETITION RULES

PLAY (SINGLES OR DOUBLES)

CHOOSE LEAD-OFF BAGGER

To determine lead Bagger - Flip a Lob Bag in the air, players to call 'California' or 'Sandbag' before bag lands - which ever word on the bag label is facing up, that player/team chooses order of play.

Alternate throws. Only two Baggers per round.

Low point Bagger leads off next round.

SCORING

1 point for Bag-On; 3 points for Bag-In. Net Differential Scoring: total up points for each player's four Bags; deduct low point total from high point total and award differential to high point Bagger. No point earned if any part of Bag is in contact with the ground.

GAME TO 21. Special recognition: 4 Bags-In (in competition only) qualifies as an official '4 BAGGER'. Celebrate wildly. Send picture to info@californiasandbag.co.nz

BAG-OFF

A Bag must be immediately removed from Board if:

- 1.) Bagger's foot touches throw line during toss (Foot Fault) or,
- 2.) Thrown bag contacts ground before Board (Dirt Bag).

SHORT-GAME RULES 1.

PLAY (SINGLES OR DOUBLES)

CHOOSE LEAD-OFF BAGGER. Alternate throws. Only two Baggers per round. Low point Bagger leads off next round. SCORING - As per Full Rules, but Game to 11.

SHORT-GAME RULES 2.

PLAY (SINGLES OR DOUBLES)

CHOOSE LEAD-OFF BAGGER. Alternate throws. Only two Baggers per round.

SCORING - First player/team to achieve 5 Bag-ins total.

(Bag-ins do not have to be consecutive).
